Besides my social and Philanthropy activities, I have the following contributions in the Field of education till date.

- 1984** Joined Rourkela Institute of Management studies
- 1985** Opened up the NIPM chapter in RIMS
- 1986** The Joint Secretary of Kanak Manjari Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences (**KMIP Sc.**) wherein Diploma in Pharmacy was imparted. After becoming the Joint Secretary, I took over the charge of the total management of the college in addition to my assignments in Rourkela Institute of Management Studies as a Co-coordinator.
- 1987** Launched the course for Bachelor in Pharmacy in KMIPS. Thereafter, from dust I succeeded to establish this Institution as one of the premier Institute imparting education in the field of Pharmacy.
- 1988** Realizing that there was an on coming trend towards a boom in the information Technology and sensing the urgent need to spread computer literacy in the industrial city of Rourkela, I took up the task of setting up the first full-fledged computer center in the city with the sole objective of imparting computer training. For establishing a

sound technical backup, a tie-up was made with Mafatlal group for providing the required technological Consultancy.

- 1989** The need for a full-fledged Professional Institution for imparting Management education in the western part of Orissa, especially because of the vast need of management professionals in the Industrial belt of the state. Thus, I took up the uphill task of revitalizing an already existing management Institute, Rourkela Institute of Management Studies, which was on the verge of decay. After I took up the Institute in the capacity of the head of the Institution namely the Director, the Institute received permanent affiliations for all its courses i.e. MBA and PGDPM from the Sambalpur University, permanent concurrence from the State Govt., necessary approvals from national bodies like the AICTE and the UGC. Year after year, the Institute has grown and today it has achieved a national stature comparable to many of the Management Institutes of the country.
- 1992** Launched the course for the award of Postgraduate diploma in Computer Application.
- 1994** Nominated to Board of Studies of the Sambalpur university and consequently also to the conducting Board of the University.
- 1995** Elected as the first president of the All Orissa Management Association.
- 1996** Tried to popularize and implement the concept of Industry - Institute – Interaction through a series of localized and National Seminars and work shop and be entering into collaboration with various industrial concerns for sharing the knowledge and capabilities for the advancements in the field of professional Management. Ultimately this led the establishment of the Amareswar Avasthi Research Centre in the auspices of the RIMS. Thus, through a series of major and minor research projects I have been able to achieve substantial success in the field.
